Guidelines for Submission of Abstracts

For submissions involving more than one presenter, the abstracts to be submitted by the **lead author** for individual papers, posters and exhibits.

Abstract preparation and format

Abstracts title • Limited to 20 words in UPPER CASE

Abstract text

- In English
- Text should not exceed **300 words**, including acknowledgements
- Figures, graphs, images, tables and diagrams should not be included

Abstracts should clearly state the following:

- Aim: state the rationale or hypothesis followed by objectives
- Method(s): briefly discuss the design of the study/programme and how it was conducted
- Results/Findings: present the main results with appropriate statistics/data analysis and pertinent discussion
- Conclusions: limit the conclusions to those that are directly supported by the results
- Key words: include 3-5 key words

Only standardized abbreviations will be allowed. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full word appears the first time.

Guidelines for Submission of Abstracts

Criteria for acceptance of presentations

- An individual may only submit two abstracts as lead author.
- Presentations will be selected on the basis of merit and relevance to the field of home economics and to the Congress theme.
- All full papers must be previously unpublished.
- All presenters must register and pay a full Congress registration by 15 February 2015 or the paper/presentation will be removed from the program.
- Responsibility for transport of accepted exhibit items to and from Congress lies with the individual artist/exhibitor. All such items must be the original work of the attributed artist/exhibitor.

Types of presentation

Individual paper:

- A 15-20 minutes presentation (including time for questions) within a concurrent session. Although independent of other presentations, individual papers will be programmed according to the thematic stream and keywords nominated by the author(s).
- Papers that have a research basis will require identification on the online submission form through selection of research methodology. Abstracts for research papers should be set out with the following subheadings : Aim; Method(s); Results/findings; Conclusion.

Poster:

Authors will be required to be present with their posters at Congress for a specified period for discussion of their posters. Specifications for poster will be confirmed upon acceptance.
